JVS Environmental is opening a NEW PERMANENT ELECTRONICS RECYCLING FACILITY, located at 1 American Way in Ellsworth. The site is located behind the Ellsworth Post Office. Participants will enter the site from Almond Road, past the Beer Here Beer Distributor. JVS Environmental will be managing the site. This site will replace the monthly electronics collection program that was previously held at the Washington Mall.

The site will be open on April 16 and April 30 from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. More dates and times will be announced in a later release.

Items to be collected include computer monitors (CRTs and LCDs); computer towers and bases (CPUs); mice, keyboards and speakers; notebook computers; printers; televisions (CRTs and LCDs); Freon appliances; fluorescent tubes and CFL bulbs; and most household appliances. Vacuum cleaners, carpet scrubbers, smoke detectors, and carbon monoxide detectors will **NOT** be accepted. **Most items will be collected free of charge.**

- **Televisions will be limited to one per carload per event.**
- Damaged or dismantled TVs will be accepted for a \$50 hazardous handling fee.
- 4- and 8-foot fluorescent tubes and Compact Fluorescent Lights (CFL) will be accepted for a charge of \$2 per bulb.
- Freon appliances will be accepted, with a Freon removal fee of \$20

Washington County's Electronics Collection has serviced 9,885 residents and collected over 843,000 pounds of material through 2018.
